

April 5, 2017

A special meeting of the Alta City Council was held on the above date in the Alta City Hall Council Chambers. The meeting was called to order at 4:00 PM by Mayor Ron Neulieb with the following members present: Pam Henderson, Denny Weber, Vi Tilk, and Lee Meyer.

The agenda was approved on a motion by Weber, seconded by Tilk, with the following members voting aye: Henderson, Weber, Tilk, Meyer. Motion approved.

David Doxtad and Caleb Rasmussen presented the Council with the outcome of the drainage study done near 9th St. and S. Cherokee St. The study shows that one tile is at least partially clogged and another tile is starting to fail. They suggested that the City clean out the clogged tile and try to repair the failing tile. The Council requested Street Superintendent Pedersen move forward, per the Engineer's suggestion, and get bids to clean and repair the tiles. A third tile, between Cherokee and Main St., needs to be televised still. This will be done before bids are accepted in case something needs to be done to that tile as well. Doxtad will look into whether the original infrastructure was put in as a "City storm water project" or a drainage district project.

The next regular Council meeting has been set for Monday, May 1 at 6:00 PM at the Alta City Hall Council Chambers. Weber motioned to adjourn at 5:04 PM, seconded by Meyer, with the following members voting aye: Henderson, Weber, Tilk, Meyer.
