

June 19, 2017

A special meeting of the Alta City Council was held on the above date in the Council Chambers of the Alta City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 3:30 PM by Mayor Pro Tem Pam Henderson with the following members present: Jerry Buckendahl, Denny Weber, Vi Tilk, and Lee Meyer. Mayor Ron Neulieb was absent.

The agenda was approved on a motion by Weber, seconded by Meyer, with the following members voting aye: Henderson, Buckendahl, Weber, Tilk, Meyer. Motion approved.

Justin Yarosevich and Jen Movall of Simmering and Cory lead a brainstorming session for the comprehensive and capital improvement plan. They had already met with the other Boards and Commissions, and will host a Public Visioning session in the near future. Much discussion took place.

Discussion took place regarding the Fireworks Ordinance and what the Council's wishes are. At this time, the Council is not allowing anyone to discharge fireworks in the City of Alta. According to Ordinance and as in previous years, the Council can approve it if the request is made in writing, by a competent operator and they can provide evidence of insurance. The Council would then approve at a Council meeting. Denny and Megan will continue considering the part of the Ordinance that deals with selling fireworks.

Lastly, discussion took place regarding the Emerald Ash Borer in Alta. The street department is putting together a tree inventory. After that is done, the Council will have a much better idea of how many ash trees the City has and what their conditions are. After the number of trees is known, the Council can decide if they are going to treat them, for how long, cut them down, etc. Property owners would be responsible for their own ash trees, but the City of Alta will work on getting some information out regarding ash trees and Emerald Ash Borer.

The next regular Council meeting has been set for Monday, July 10 at 6:00 PM at the Alta City Hall Council Chambers. Weber motioned to adjourn at 5:20 PM, seconded by Tilk, with the following members voting aye: Henderson, Weber, Tilk, Meyer.
