

Guest speaker Dale Arends, Chairperson of Buena Vista Supervisors spoke to us on Tuesday. He discussed various issues:

Property taxes: These taxes are due now. The next asking next spring will be about the same rate \$10 per \$1,000. There is around \$9 million in tax income from last year.

New secondary road facility: Currently county equipment is housed in a building on Hudson Street. Hudson is a street not zoned in a residential area. The Supervisors are in the process of bidding on the purchase of the old Luedtke building on East Richland. This building features six big maintenance bays for trucks and nine smaller bays for storage. There will also be some room for Supervisor's offices. Total cost of project is \$2.8 million.

Attention will be paid to drainage ditches. A new County Attorney begins duties this fall. Bret Wilkerson will be the new Engineer.

Dale has been a Supervisor for the past 12 years. He is seeking re-election as a Republican candidate.
