

Randy Tilk, Alta Municipal Utilities Manager visited with Kiwanis Tuesday morning. Randy is in charge of city electrical, water, and telecommunications systems. Recently the city purchased 8 acres of land north of the fairgrounds. May of this year Alta will drill well #6. This is to replace a well which dried up a year or so ago. Well #6 will be on the south end of this 8-acre parcel of land. A new water line will run from the new fire station to well #6. Well #7 can be drilled on the north end of the parcel after #6 dries up. In 2013-2014, Alta water works underwent extensive repairs. This has improved water quality for Alta residents. Randy offered up a helpful hint the next times hydrants are flushed, turn on an outside faucet and let it run until water is clear.

Electrical: Much underground placement of electrical wiring in Alta has been completed. GPS has been added in order to locate underground electrical in case of a natural disaster.

Telecommunications: digital programming has been switched over.
