

BV County Supervisor Tom Huseman was our guest speaker this past Tuesday. The county plans to build a new maintenance shed along Radio Road for a cost of \$2 million. The new shed will have 12 bays which will allow trucks and other equipment to be stored inside. The County Engineer's office will be located at this site. This building will take the place of the current Hudson Street site. Currently both Tyson and the Rail Road may be interested in purchasing the Hudson Street property.
