

Tuesday morning's guest speaker was Bret Wilkinson, Buena Vista County Engineer. Bret stated that a portion of asphalt repaving of C-49 and M-50 has been completed. The C-49 project will be on-going due to a large box culvert which needs reworking. Upcoming is a big bridge replacement by Linn Grove. This project will take six-seven months to complete. Several personnel have retired from gravel-grading and snow removal. New personnel have been hired and are now in training. Winter operators are needed.

Bret said construction of a new storage building on Radio Road is progressing. They plan to move into the new building by March 2019. This new facility will replace the one on Hudson Street. The Radio Road site features 12 bays for trucks and other road equipment storage. Also, recently two more trucks were added. These are used to haul gravel and limestone from Gilmore City area.
