

Dave McCoy, Treasurer of Alta-Aurelia Athletic Boosters and member of Youth Football program spoke to us on Tuesday morning. A-A Boosters Club has 12 members. The club gets income from 3 or 4 clothing sales throughout the school year. In the past, they operated the concession stand during basketball season. Low numbers of people to work the stand caused them to give up this endeavor. Monies earned are returned to help pay for various needs by the athletic department. These included purchasing uniforms, wrestling mat covers, donations to athletes competing in state tournaments, a radar gun for baseball and updates to the audio system at the baseball field. In 2017-2018 the Booster Club returned \$15,000 toward construction of a storage building at the ballfields. Youth football program season runs from Aug-Oct. This program involves 50+ kids from 3rd-6th grade. This year 3rd and 4th grade will be combined. Financial help comes from donations of family, friends, and organizations like our local Kiwanis clubs.
