

October 21, 2019

A special meeting of the Alta City Council was held on the above date in the Council Chambers of the Alta City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by Mayor Al Clark with the following members present: Willie Lang, Wes Bunjes, and Denny Weber. Vi Tilk arrived at 5:38 pm, and Kevin Walsh arrived at 5:40 pm.

The agenda was approved on a motion by Weber, seconded by Lang, with the following members voting aye: Lang, Bunjes, and Weber. Motion approved.

Jennifer Movall and Justin Yarosevich presented information regarding the Comprehensive Plan, on behalf of Simmering & Cory. They presented a future land-use map, a Residential Development Concept map, and an Entry Improvement Concept map. The Council was given a list of preliminary objectives and they are to prioritize, individually, what they would like to see done in 1-5 years, 6-10 years, and 11+ years. Those results will be put together and presented to the Council in the near future.

Discussion took place regarding getting security hired for Alta Community Building events that order alcohol. More discussion will take place at the next Council meeting.

The Council gave the Code Officer, Matt Hess, an employment review. Discussion took place regarding Matt's job performance as the Alta Community Building Manager/Cleaner, and the City of Alta Code Officer. After some discussion, including input from some community members on behalf of Hess, Tilk moved to discontinue Matt Hess's employment with the City of Alta, seconded by Lang, with the following members voting aye: Bunjes, Tilk, Weber, and Lang. Walsh voted nay. Motion carried.

There being no further business, Tilk moved to adjourn at 7:35, seconded by Lang, with the following members voting aye: Bunjes, Tilk, Weber, Walsh, and Lang. Motion carried. Next meeting is the regular meeting scheduled for Nov. 4, at 6:00 pm.
