

Guest speaker Tuesday morning was Randy Tilk--- Alta Utilities. Randy has been on the job since 2012. Alta Utilities is rate based whereas the city runs off taxes. Improvements include a tie-line added to transmission in case of emergencies. 2 generators added a year or 2 ago. currently, there is a study underway to determine cost of burying all above ground lines in Alta. There is also a plan to replace all land lines and eventually go to cell phones. Although a few years ago a \$1.7 million was spent to rebuild the waterplant, the old water system still has some old pipes and fixtures dating from 1950's-- 1970's. After the water plant was rebuilt a well went down. A different land area had to be found to dig a new well. A new site was located and well #6 was dug in 2018. Since then well #4 became corroded and well #7 has been drilled. In 2018, old pipes were replaced on Leander St. This put pressure on existing older pipes that since 2019 5 more leaks had to be repaired.
