

**ORDINANCE NO. 22-01**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2014 ALTA CITY CODE,  
BY AMENDING TITLE IV, CHAPTER 23: ATV'S, ORUV'S,  
RECREATIONAL VEHICLES & SNOWMOBILES, ARTICLE 15, SECTION  
15.14 OFF ROAD UTILITY VEHICLES

**WHEREAS**, the City Code on file in the office of the City Clerk designates certain standards as provided by Chapter 414, Iowa Code, and

**WHEREAS**, it is deemed advisable and recommended by the Planning and Zoning Commission to amend Title IV, Chapter 23: ATVs, ORUVs, recreational vehicles, and snowmobiles, article 15, Section 15.14 Off Road Utility Vehicles of the Alta Zoning Ordinance.

**NOW THEREFORE IT BE ORDAINED**, by the City Council of Alta, Iowa;

Section 1.

CHANGE Section 15.14 to 15.15 so that it is uniform with the items below it

Section 15.15(d) Special Use Permits. Change text to read as follows:

1. ORUV operators may apply for a yearly permit from the Alta City Clerk/Administrator on forms provided by the City. This permit is required to be carried in the ORUV with the proof of insurance.
- 2b. Evidence that the operator is at least 16 years of age, and possesses a valid Iowa driver's license.

Section 15.15 (e) Authorized Uses. Add text:

5. General/Recreational usage.

Section 15.15 (g) Operation. Change text to read as follows:

1. No person shall operate an ORUV on any city street, alley or right-of-way who is not at least sixteen (16) years of age and does not have a valid Iowa Driver's license. Ages 16-17 must complete and carry a certificate from the Iowa DNR.
6. Hours of Operation. No ORUV shall be operated in the City of Alta between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 5:00 am.
7. All operators must follow the Iowa Code Chapters 321 and 321I and the Iowa Administrative Code, Chapter 571. Copies are available at the Alta City Hall or you can go to [www.iowadnr.gov](http://www.iowadnr.gov).


Section 2. **REPEALER**. All ordinances or parts of the previously adopted Alta Zoning Ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this zoning amendment are hereby repealed.

Section 3. **SEVERABILITY CLAUSE**. If any section, provision or any part of this zoning amendment is determined to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the previously adopted Alta Zoning Ordinance as a whole.


Section 4. **EFFECTIVE DATE**. This zoning amendment shall be in full force and effect from after passage and publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
